

- 61 million people live in London and SE England)
- 54 million of those live in England (Scotland 5.3m Males 1.1m and NI 1.8m)
- has only 20 million people

Definitions

- Distribution the way it which mething is spread over an area
- Population Density is a mercurement of the number of people it an area. It is calculated by dividing the number of people by the area. Population Tensity is usually shown as the number of people per square kilometre.
- Places which are sparsely populated contain to people. Places which are densely populated contain many people


